- <u>Paint the hill</u> they climbed and add Jack and Jill climbing the hill.




Learn the rhyme (see rhyme sheet).


Practise saying the rhyme aloud. Make actions to go along with the rhyme.

Jack and Jill went up the hill to fetch a pail (bucket) of water. Fill up your sink or a big bowl. Use cups, jugs and other containers to scoop and pour water. Measure how many cups of water each item can hold. Add bubbles and other toys for extra fun!
