Reading

Complete one of your comprehension sheets and mark it. If you wish, let me know which one you completed and how you got on in the library channel.




Spelling

Writing

Weekend Recount

Write a recount of what you got up to at the weekend. Remember to make it detailed, neat and interesting. Here is what I am expecting from....

Everyone:

- Finger spaces - Letters on the line - Neat Work - Letters formed correctly - Sounding out tricky words

Most Pupils:

- Interesting word choices - Simple conjunctions (and, but) - Simple Time connectives (then, next) - Adjectives - Spelling common words correctly

Some Pupils:

- Adverbs - Splitting work into paragraphs - Advanced conjunctions (because, therefore) - Advanced time connectives (meanwhile, finally, suddenly)

You are all good at your recounts and know what makes a good one. Have a chat about your weekend before you start writing. Check your work over at the end to make sure it makes sense and to double check spellings.
