# Literacy:

In literacy this term we will focus on description. We will work on describing characters, settings and developing these ideas to create imaginative stories. This will link to our class comprehension and grammar programmes.

We will work on presentation and spelling throughout all our literacy tasks.

Reading will take place in class through our various curricular areas. This term we will focus on the skills of summarising and inferencing.

#### Numeracy:

In Primary 7, we will be consolidating our learning of addition and subtraction and learning strategies for long multiplication and division. We will be applying our knowledge into everyday problems.

We will continue to develop our mental maths strategies in order to solve mental maths problems. We will continually practise our tables to help us with recall and problem solving activities.

This term our topic maths focus will be on Angles, Symmetry and Transformation.

# Digital Literacy + ICT:

This term we will be developing our knowledge of coding using a range of different coding programs and toys. We will be continuing to work on our digital literacy by using our digital skills across the curriculum.
