Festive Arrangements

Uniform

The concert will be held at the Baptist Church Centre. P1 & P2 present "The Twinkly Nativity" and P5 & P6 present "Neverland". The classes will be practising at the church before the shows, and the teachers will advise of arrangements for this via Wakelet

The dress rehearsal will be held on **Tuesday 12th December** at 1.30 p.m. with the whole school going to watch. All classes will be released from the church centre at the end of the school day: please make sure that anyone collecting a child is aware of this. Adults are invited to watch the dress rehearsal if they wish, but will require a ticket as we need to ensure audience numbers are within fire regulations. There is no charge for the dress rehearsal, but we will be collecting donations for a charity of the children's choosing.

The evening performance will be held on **Wednesday 13th December** at 5 p.m. Entry to this performance is by ticket only, as we must ensure audience numbers are within fire regulations. As per the letter sent out previously, each family is allocated 4 tickets and should have requested these by **Tuesday 28th November**. We will then try to accommodate additional ticket requests from 4th December.
