In literacy this term we will focus on exposition and discussion texts. This will link to our class comprehension and grammar programmes.

Reading will take place in class through our various curricular areas. Our novel study will be based on the novel Wonder R. J. Palacio which explores prejudice, selfacceptance and friendship.

Spelling activities will be completed throughout and spell checks completed on a Friday.

Numeracy:

In Primary 6, we will be consolidating our learning of place value and estimating & rounding. Later in the term we will be investigating negative number.

We will continue to develop our mental maths strategies in order to solve mental maths problems. We will continually practise our tables to help us with recall and problem solving activities.

This term our topic maths focus will be on Time and Chance and Uncertainty.
