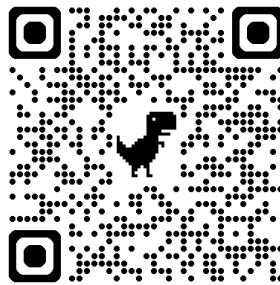
Woodwork
