
Nursery Newsletter

Please read details below about Nursery and School Enrolments. If you have any queries please speak to or contact a member of staff who will be able to support.

Nursery Enrolment

The dates for Nursery Enrolment are *Monday 20th January to Friday 24th January 2025*. Please make sure forms are handed back in no later than *24th January*. Please read the following for options below:

- If your child is returning to nursery for a second year, an *ELC 2* form will be in your child's mail drop. Please fill this in and return to Nursery as soon as possible.
- If you are deferring your child from P1 this year please fill out the *ELC 2* form in your child's mail drop.
- If you have another child/sibling coming to Nursery for the first time, please fill out an *ELC 1* form. You should receive a letter from the council about enrolment. When you fill in this form you must also bring along with you *proof of address* and your *child's birth certificate*.

School Enrolment

School enrolment forms will be handed out on **Monday 27**th **January**. These are to be returned on **Friday 31**st **January**. Please read the following for options below:

- If your catchment school is Calside and you wish your child to attend Calside Primary, please fill in the 'Catchment Application Form' and hand it into the school office. You do not need a birth certificate or proof of address as your child will already be in the school system as they attend Nursery.
- If your child is not going to attend your catchment school, you must take your 'Pupil Placing Request Form' to your catchment school. On this form you will indicate which school you wish to attend. You will need to take along your child's birth certificate and proof of address.
- If you are attending your catchment school and it is not Calside Primary, please take along 'Catchment Application' form and hand it into your school with proof of address and your child's birth certificate.

These forms will shared on or before the 17^{th} January. They are also available online.

- Please can you put your child's name on everything. It makes it easier for staff to locate and find personal belongings and clothing as children cannot always identify items belong to them.
- In Nursery we have a policy of 'No Juice'. Please fill water bottles with water. This also helps with cross contamination as children will gravitate and drink bottles with juice causing spreading of germs.
