## Parental Support

- With the warmer weather coming in, can you please make sure that your child brings a water bottle with them each day to nursery. To fall in line with our healthy eating policies, we ask that this is **WATER ONLY**. If you feel your child cannot drink water, please speak to a member of staff.
- If your child requires a toy from home for transition purposes, please let a staff member know. Children get very upset when their toys from home get broken or played without their permission.
- If your child is absent from nursery please send us a Dojo message detailing the reason. This helps us monitor illness.
- As the weather is so hot at the moment, please make sure that you apply sun cream to your child. We will re-apply after lunchtime with the bottle that you have provided for us.
- Ensuring your child has their shoulders covered and a sun hat helps us keep your child comfortable to access outdoors during hotter spells.

## **Reminder of Transition Dates and Detail from for those going into Primary One at Calside**

**Transition Programme Monday 16th June 3.15-4.15 p.m.** "Going on a Bear Hunt" The Buddies cordially invite you to join them (with teddies) for the Going on a Bear Hunt. This is a social event to build your child's confidence within school, with the Buddies organising play activities. Refreshments will be available.

**Wednesday 25th June 1.30- 2.45 p.m:** "Pupil Class Time" Please bring your child to the P1 entrance. Once your child is settled with their class teacher, please make your way along to the hall where you will have an opportunity to share a cuppa with the other P1 parents. The P1 teacher will then share with you what to expect during their first few weeks at Calside, and there will be an opportunity to look round the school if you are not yet familiar. While in class, the children will all have some time with their P7 buddies who will guide and support them during their first few weeks with us.

**Thursday 26th June 11.15 a.m.** "Pupil Class Time/Buddy Time" Please bring your child to the P1 entrance. If your child shows any concerns about this arrangement, you are welcome to settle your child in class and then feel free to go. On this day, there is an opportunity for your child to stay in school and have lunch. This is provided free of charge.
