Please note we have a child in the Nursery with a severe nut allergy. It is essential that no nuts or products containing nuts are brought into the Nursery. It would be greatly appreciated if you could try to avoid bringing products into Nursery that say they may contain nut traces. It would be helpful if you could check that children have thoroughly washed their hands before attending Nursery if they have been in contact with nuts.

Please be vigilant with this over the Halloween period and also if bringing in chocolates, biscuits, etc.

All children:

We would be grateful if you could avoid leaving food in children's bags or coats. Please check that your child has thoroughly washed their hands before attending Nursery if your child has eaten foods containing nuts, e.g. honey nut cornflakes, Nutella on toast or any other nut containing product such as chocolate.

Packed Lunches

Please be careful to check that any food being sent in packed lunch boxes does not contain nuts or trace amounts of nuts. As any items from lunchboxes will need to be bagged at Nursery before being put in the fridge to prevent cross contamination, please send items in small containers instead of large multi section lunchboxes or put items in smaller containers/bags within the sections.

Wednesday 8th November: 11.20am and 2.30pm: Make a memory box event.


