Each child has a key worker at Nursery. The Nursery staff work as a team to plan and deliver overall learning and care in the Nursery; however, your child's key worker takes responsibility for nurturing your child's learning and development, updating their Learning Folder and reviewing your child's care plan. We have key worker 'group times' in Nursery too where children take part in activities with their key worker for 15 minutes, e.g. singing songs, talking about a story or discussing our topic. We have made some changes to the groups over the holidays and as a result your child's key worker may not be the member of staff you completed your initial care plan with; however, all key workers will make sure they are familiar with their group's care plans. All members of staff are happy to speak to you at any time if you have any questions, comments or concerns or you would like to update us on your children's needs or achievements. We run open evenings too several times a year for you to find out more about your child's learning and achievements at Nursery.

An appointment can also made at any time with Mrs Mackenzie if you wish to have a longer chat about your child's learning experiences or care at Nursery.
