First day of your child's week: CAPER



Please send in your child's folder on their first day at Nursery each week and it will be sent out with a new book and rhyme by the end of the week.

Occasionally, we are not able to send books home on weeks where we have no CAPER helper.

Tuesdays: Outdoor Messy Play Day





Please send children in clothes suitable for getting messy outside. Please make sure

they have their wellies at Nursery. They will be taken in small groups to play in the Messy Play garden for part of the session.

Thursdays AM and PM: Hall (PE)

Most days: Sports Practice Outside

Leggings or trousers are recommended for the hall. Please send children in comfortable and safe clothing for physical activity.

We will also be practising for sports outside on most days. Please ensure children are dressed appropriately for this.

Everyday: Bike Play

We can now facilitate bike play everyday as part of our free flow play which is a fantastic improvement to our outdoor provision.

We have taken the decision to only use helmets on balance bikes and bikes due to issues with fitting generic helmets for each child. We no longer use helmets on trikes. If you have any concerns about this or wish to provide a helmet for your child to keep at Nursery to use on trikes, please speak to Mrs Mackenzie.







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Sun Safety:

It will soon be sunny and warm (I hope!). Please apply a long acting sun cream at home. It is advisable to send children in long sleeved tops to prevent sun burn. We would be grateful if you could send your child with the following items.

Please put these items in their TRAY with their names written on all the items where possible:

- *Additional sun cream that they can apply themselves.
- *Sun hat
- *Sun glasses







Spare Clothing:

We are now very short of clothing supplies for when children have accidents and all our recently purchased pants, etc. have been used up and not returned. Please return any clothing that is supplied by the Nursery.

Yellow Bags:

We would be grateful if you could regularly check your children's yellow bags to ensure that they have at least one full change of clothes, including pants. This is a good idea even if your child is toilet trained as they can become wet or dirty in the play areas. Ideally, it is nicer for your child to be given familiar clothes if they need to be changed. Thank you for your help with this.

Fundraiser: Sponsored Athletics/ Daily Run 11th-15th June

On this week, we will be running a sponsored daily physical activity/ challenge, i.e. jumping jacks, small obstacle race, etc. for the children as part of their daily run time. We would be grateful if you would consider sponsoring your child to take part in these activities. A certificate of achievement will be provided for all those involved. Half of the funds raised will go towards the payment of the enlargement of the fenced area that recently took place and the other half of the funds raised will be used to purchase more bikes and outdoor equipment. We are sure that this will be a fun event to take part in. Letters will be sent out soon to parents regarding this.



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Snack/Activity Fund:

Snack and Activity/Resources Fund: The suggested donation for the snack/activity/resources fund is **50p** per session (£1 per back to back day) or £2.50 per week. In addition to our daily snack, our snack and activity fund also helps to pay for a variety of activities and resources in Nursery such as parties, birthday treats/books, special crafts, family learning events such as Christmas crafts sessions, small toys and resources, baking/cooking activities as part of snack and any other special activities in the Nursery. Please write your child's name on an envelope and place their snack money inside. This should be left in the basket above the tray unit in the playroom. You can also pay snack termly if you prefer.

The cost for Term 3 was £29. If you have still to arrange to put in this suggested donation, please hand this in to the office as soon as possible. We appreciate your help with this.



The cost for Term 4 is £26.50.

<u>Lunch Money:</u> If your child attends all day and has school lunches, please put the money for this in a <u>separate envelope</u> to the snack money as the school lunch money is sent to the kitchen. School lunches now cost £1.85. School lunch menus are available in Nursery.

Transition to Primary 1 Activities

I have been in touch with all the relevant Primary 1 settings that the children are moving on to and have invited Primary 1 staff to contact me regarding planning your child's transition into Primary 1. Mrs Gallacher has been visiting the Nursery to get to know the children moving to Cargenbridge and we have planned a range of shared play events over different days and sessions. We will involve all pre-school children in some of the shared play events. Cargenbridge staff will get in touch with parents soon regarding P7 buddies and induction visits. What an exciting time for the children!
