Snack and Activities Fund

To help fund snacks, activities and resources throughout your child's time at Cargenbridge Nursery, there is a suggested donation of **50p per session** (£1 per back to back day).

<u>Important</u> – to save paper, we have now replaced our money envelopes with tubs. Each child has an individual named tub, so please use these for any snack money.

The total cost for Term 2 is £20.00, but we can take this in weekly instalments or daily if you prefer. Please just speak to Mrs Boardman or one of the nurses if you have any questions.

Lunch Money

If your child attends all day, this is charged at £1.85 per day.

Menus are available in the Nursery. Please just ask a member of staff for information.

Please note – Lunch money is still collected separately in envelopes to be sent to the kitchen. Please mark your child's name on the envelope as before.

PE - Wed AM and Thurs PM

The Nursery PE days through Term 2 will continue as before on Wednesday morning and Thursday afternoon.
