Involve parents and children in setting their own next steps for learning, ensuring that next steps focus on key individualised areas for that child.	<ul> <li>We have made good progress with this priority because</li> <li>We worked closely with family learning coordinator to plan events for the year. Family learning session for health and wellbeing and science was held.</li> <li>A Focus week information sheet was sent home to parents the week before the child's focus week. Parents could send in information on this about current interests and learning. They could identify areas that they would like to know about their child's learning or areas of learning they feel they are not accessing at home, e.g. numbers, jigsaws.</li> <li>Termly learning conversations were made available for parents in addition to care plans.</li> <li>Plan, Do, Review has been implemented to enable children to develop the language to plan their learning, make decisions, ask for resources and review their learning.</li> <li>*Staff are talking to children about their next steps when a new next step is formulated. Children are given a sticker to encourage parents to ask them about their learning and to check their folder for the next step.</li> <li>Pages have been added to the next steps to enable parents to make comments about their progress at home and a blank copy of the tracking information used is available for parents to look at and use.</li> <li>We are continued to embed the pictorial catalogue of resources to widen children's decisions in the Nursery.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Encourage children to vocalise their plans and resources they need in their general play.
