School Car Park Reminder

The following information is important!!

NO PARKING on the roundabout in the middle of the car park.

DO NOT park in the disabled parking bays unless you carry a disabled parking badge.

DO NOT park on the Single Yellow Lines on Waterside Road—It is difficult to exit safely from the school car park when cars are parked right up to the entrance.

DO NOT park in the 'Drop Off' bays as they are for dropping off only. If using it to collect your child they should be waiting for you in the bay. DO NOT park and wait for them! When using the School Car Park — Children should be supervised at all times.

Please ensure to remind all those extended family members and Childminders of this information.

There is an alternative area where you can 'park and stride'. In Woodley Court there is a small car park which can be used and entry to the school can be made by the back gate. ****
