Update on 20mph measures for Cargenbridge/Waterside Road from the Council......

"There has been an objector to the proposals, therefore a report has to go to the Nithsdale Area Committee to consider this on 11th Sept 2019. The Area Committees as authority: In accordance with the provisions of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999 issued under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to determine Road Traffic Orders.

If the Nithsdale Area Committee 'agree to the implementation of the (Various Speed Limits) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 as advertised', then it can proceed to the made Order process (6 week advertising period), following which the 20mph speed limit scheme can be installed......"
