On these days parents always have the choice to play safe and keep them at home or collect early due to their circumstances. If we have to close the school we will inform you via, Groupcall, school facebook and it will be posted on the Council website. It may also be communicated via local media. Sometimes the decision to close the school cannot be taken straight away as we need time to assess our own situation, so please bear with us. At times we may also adopt a later start to allow the early rush to pass which sometimes makes journeys easier and it gives people more time to commute. If the school has to close during the day, all children must be collected from the school by an adult. If it is not their parent you must inform us who will be collecting your child. All children will remain in school until collected. Fingers crossed the weather is kind to us but we need to ensure everyone is prepared for the winter weather.
