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Mrs Watson says As positive cases continue to remain high please continue to follow these guidelines....

- Please remember to inform the school of all results of Covid PCR tests, negative and positive.
- Also a reminder that if a member of your household has Covid symptoms, the rest of the household must isolate until you receive the results of the PCR test, then NHS guidance should be followed. Children must have a PCR test and have received the results before returning.
- New guidance has been issued from the Scottish Government and now if a child tests positive for Covid, then a warn and inform letter will only be sent to the child's class. This letter strongly encourages all parents to organise for their child to have a lateral flow test before returning to school.
- As always we ask parents to err on the side of caution and keep their child off school if unwell and book a test if needed.

It continues to be a very difficult time for us all and at times people are receiving conflicting information. If in doubt please contact the school office so the best decision can be made to keep everyone safe.
