As positive cases continue to remain high please continue to follow these guidelines...

- Please remember and inform the school of all results of Covid PCR tests, negative and positive before sending your child back to school.
- Also a reminder that if a member of your household has Covid symptoms, the rest of the household must isolate
 until you receive the results of the PCR test, then NHS guidance should be followed. Children must have a PCR test
 if they display one of the 3 main symptoms.
- As always we ask parents to err on the side of caution and keep their child off school if unwell and book a test if needed.

If in doubt please contact the school office so the best decision can be made to keep everyone safe. Thank you for your continued support. School Improvement Planning 2021/22

This year we have 2 school improvement priorities and we are also continuing with our Education Scotland areas for improvement from our Inspection in March 2019. Our progress against those Education Scotland priorities was detailed in a letter which was issued at the end of last term. We are also still focusing on health and wellbeing and Recovery following recent Covid lockdowns. Our priorities are:-

To raise attainment in reading and writing through a whole school approach called "Creating a Balance Reader and Writer"

- All teaching staff will attend training sessions with follow up sessions being carried out in class.
- A whole school approach will be planned and resourced ready for full implementation in the next school year.

To raise attainment in numeracy through the Developing Number Knowledge Approach and through reviewing our current resources and programme

- Self evaluate the current maths resources used in the school.
- Introduce new resources to better support the development of maths and numeracy across the school as necessary.
 - Staff to have further training in the Developing Number Knowledge Approach.
