Welcome back and Happy New Year. We hope that as we move through 2022 things will settle down again and we will all have a bit more normality. It is great to see all the children back in school and hear all about their holidays.

Thank you to all for following our H and S measures and for ensuring that we all stay safe and learning continues. Please continue to follow all the new isolation procedures and if there is a positive case in your household please contact the school prior to your child coming into school so we can discuss the best options for your situation.

In order to keep everyone safe can all parents carry out regular Lateral Flow Tests on your child as many children who test positive have no symptoms or do not have any of the 3 main symptoms. If you receive a Warn and Inform letter to let you know someone has tested positive in your child's class, a lateral flow test should be done before your child comes back to school the next day in order to protect all children and staff. Many thanks and hopefully as we move through January things will improve in Dumfries and Galloway.

<u>Ventilation</u>

Just to remind everyone that National Covid guidance asks us to ensure that all classes are well ventilated this means that at times of the day the windows and perhaps the class door may be open. Each class has a CO2 monitor to help monitor the ventilation. Please ensure your child does come to school dressed appropriately and with extra layers if needed.
