The Newsletter will continue to be issued fortnightly by email. This newsletter is very important as it shares dates and important information, so please ensure you read this and keep any information safe for you to refer to. The term dates we have so far are below, some more may be added.

We have no extra Covid restrictions in place any more apart from keeping our rooms well ventilated and strict hand hygiene. We all know though that Covid is still in our communities so please continue to be vigilant and if your child is unwell with any of the Covid symptoms they should be tested if possible and kept at home. The last guidance we received was that if children test positive they should remain at home for 3 days with day one being the day after they test positive. They can return if they are well enough to be at school after this period.

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Health Promoting School

We do expect every child to come to school with water in a suitable water bottle. The children can drink this throughout the day. We also expect snacks to be healthy—such as fruit or raw veg, yoghurt, etc, no crisps, sweets or chocolate biscuits. In relation to packed lunches, everyone deserves a treat but please try to limit the amount of sugary food included in the packed lunch. We are a health promoting school and we want to ensure what our pupils eat and drink do not effect their focus and concentration during learning time. Remember we are a nut free school as we have a child who has a nut allergy. No food with any type of nut should be brought into school. Thank you for your support.

Sign A Long

This year we are introducing all the children to Sign A Long as another form of communication in school and this can also be used out with school too. Please ask your child to teach you what they have learned so far.

Sickness and Diarrhoea Bugs

Reminder that children should not return to school until 48 hours after the last bout of this. This is to help stop the spread of this bug. Thank you.

School Uniform

We do pride ourselves in our children coming to school dressed smartly in their school uniform. On non PE days children should come to school wearing their uniform. No sports tops should be worn as part of this. The school black hoodies with the school badge or plain black hoodies can be worn but not ones with other logos or brands on them. We are aware that school uniforms are costly, we do have some good quality pre loved uniform in school if this would be helpful to anyone. If so please contact the school.

Every child does need indoor shoes to change into for the classrooms and for indoor PE. If you need help providing these for your child please contact the school and we can help you out.

<u>Car Park and collection at 3pm</u>

For everyone and all our new parents we are still using a one way system to enter the playground, in through the small gate and out through the large gate. The car park is busy so if you have a big vehicle you can park through the gates to the left of the gate right in front to the MUGA. Children do cross there so please be vigilant. Parents should not park anywhere else inside the gates. Please ensure that adults supervise their children leaving the school as it is busy. Thank you.

Special Dietary Requirements

If your child has a special diet they need to follow due to medical issues or cultural background, then forms need to be completed. These can be collected from the office.

School Lunches

Update on school lunches. We are part of the online payment and ordering system for School dinners. Parents can still order online but Mrs Rogerson is still going around the classes each morning to take orders as necessary. Parents can either pay through this online payment system or still in cash to the school. P1 parents should have received a letter about how to register with this. The introduction of Free school meals for P6 and P7 by the Government has unfortunately been delayed, we will inform you when these will start when we know.

For those who may find this helpful, parents can apply for free school meals and a clothing grant. If you wish to do so then please contact the office for information.
