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Health Promoting School

We do expect every child to come to school with water in a suitable water bottle. The children can drink this throughout the day. We also expect snacks to be healthy - such as fruit or raw veg, yoghurt,etc, no crisps, sweets or chocolate biscuits. In relation to packed lunches, everyone deserves a treat but please try to limit the amount of sugary food included in the packed lunch. We are a health promoting school and we want to ensure what our pupils eat and drink do not effect their focus and concentration during learning time. Remember we are a nut free school. No food with any type of nut should be brought into school. Also no fizzy drinks are allowed. Thank you for your support.

Sickness and Diarrhoea Bugs/Illness

Reminder that children should not return to school until 48 hours after the last bout of this. This is to help stop the spread of this bug. If your child is poorly in any way then the best place for them is at home, please keep them off school until they are better. Thanks

Sign A Long

Last year we introduce all the children to Sign A Long as another form of communication in school and this can also be used out with school too. Please ask your child to teach you what they have learned so far.

Special Dietary Requirements If your child has a special diet they need to follow due to medical issues or cultural background, then forms need to be completed. These can be collected from the office.

Update on school lunches. We are part of the online payment and ordering system for School dinners. Parents can order on line but Mrs Rogerson is still going around the classes each morning to take or-Rogerson is still going around the classes each morning to take or-ders as necessary. Parents can either pay through this online pay-ment system or still in cash to the school. **P1 parents will receive a letter about how to register with this. The introduction of** free school meals for P6 and P7 by the Government has un-fortunately still been delayed. So P6 and P7 pupils still need to pay. If due to a change of circumstances you may be enti-tled to free school meals and clothing grants so please look on the council website for information.

PE days

All children should come to school in their PE clothes on a Friday and the following days for the classes Monday P3/4 Tuesday P2/3 and P1 Wednesday P4/5/6 and P6/7

No football colours should be worn as part of their PE clothes.

School Uniform

We do pride ourselves in our children coming to school dressed smartly in their school uniform. On non PE days children should come to school wearing their uniform. No sports tops or brands should be worn as part of this. The school black hoodies with the school badge or plain black hoodies can be worn but not ones with other logos or brands on them. We are aware that school uniforms are costly, we do have some good quality pre loved uniform in school if this would be helpful to anyone. If so please contact the school. Please ensure all clothes are named.

Every child does need indoor shoes to change into for the classrooms and for indoor PE. If you need help providing these for your child please contact the school and we can help you out.

<u>Coats to School</u>

Scottish weather is very changeable as we know so please ensure your child brings a jacket with them to school each day. We do like to get them outside at breaks as much as we can.

<u>Cycling to School</u> We do encourage children to cycle to school if you feel they are capable of doing so. If so they must wear a helmet and bikes can be stored in the bike shed. Please can you remind children that the bike shed is in the staff car park and therefore they should be be arriving at school, especially if they are unsupervised by an adult. Also all bikes should be pushed through the playground. Thank you

The children should enter the hall via the door at the side of the hall in the staff car park. Please be careful when entering as staff may be arriving at school at this time. Children from Nursery can only attend Breakfast Club if they are with brothers or sisters from the school.

<u>School Facebook Group</u> We have a school private facebook group which parents can join. This group gives lots of information and is a quick way to share information and celebrate our children's learning with you. For all those who are not members you can request to join by answering some questions. You can ask generic questions on this group but if there is anything personal please contact the school direct.

Car Park—Important Reminder - We have new intakes in Nursery and in school which has increased the amount of new car owners in the car park so it is important that everyone follows the following procedures: -

The car park is very busy at the start and end of the day so please follow these rules.

- Please remember that the drop off zone should only be used to drop off and pick up if your child is waiting for you. It is not another parking spot and cars should not be parking with their car facing towards Waterside Rd.
- Also a small amount of cars larger can park through the gates in front of the MUGA. This is the only place to park through the gates as this is a pedestrian area and staff car park. If others park along the fence then others will follow suit. If cars park there they will be asked to move.
- Remember there is a roundabout in the middle of the car park so cars should not park on this. If you park on Waterside Road please do not park on the painted lines as this blocks the view of those leaving the car park.
 - Only disabled badge owners should park in the disabled bays.
 - If you want to use the back gate there is alternative parking at Woodley Court
- All these procedures are in place to keep everyone safe! Please ensure all those other members of your family who drop off and pick up are aware of these procedures.
