Head Lice

Over the past few months we have been told about quite a few cases of Head Lice across Nursery and the School. If your child has them please can you let us know so we can monitor things. The recent advise is that if you take a live head lice to the chemist you will get free lotion to use to treat them. Follow the guidance on the lotion and let all those who you have been mixing with know so they can keep an eye out. The best thing is to use a nit comb and comb through using conditioner on a regular basis. Those who don't have head lice/eggs should not use the lotion as the head lice can build up a resistance to it and it wont be affective. Here is the link to the NHS website for further information .
