WHAT DOES THE PARENT TEACHER COUNCIL DO?

- Raises funds to support various activities and learning; this includes money going towards: additional classroom resources, school trips and end of term gifts, treats and bookbags.
- Works with the staff to support learning and teaching, school improvement and parental and community engagement.
- Offers an opportunity to discuss any concerns directly with the staff and then work together to find constructive solutions.

WHY SHOULD I COME / VOLUNTEER TO BE INVOLVED?

- It's a chance to hear what's going on and bring new ideas which can benefit the kids and school as a whole.
- You don't have to do any more than just come and listen—there are loads of way to get involved from giving up a couple of hours as a one-off, through to helping run an event but just coming to show your support is great too.
