Norovirus like illnesses

There are norovirus like illnesses (sickness and diarrhoea) in the Nursery at the moment. Please ensure that you phone us to let us know if your child is off with any illness and please keep your child off for at least 48 hours after the last episode of symptoms if they are off with sickness/diarrhoea.

Important Dates

Tuesday 15th and Wednesday 16th January: Primary 1 Enrolment

You will need to collect a form from your key worker on one of these days, unless your child is in the catchment area for another school. Further details regarding the enrolment process have been sent out in a separate letter.

Tuesday 5th and Thursday 7th February: Care Plans

Please note that the care planning is not related to enrolment. We have been reviewing our procedures and are now changing the Nursery care planning process to include parent appointments to check contact details, medical information, individual needs etc on a six monthly basis. Please make an appointment time and arrive fifteen minutes <u>before</u> this time to collect and complete a SEEMIS contact details update form. Mrs Mackenzie will then complete the care plan form (currently on display beneath the appointments list) with you.

Wednesday 27th and Thursday 28th February: Pre-school Enrolment

Children attending Nursery from August 2013, January 2014 and April 2014 need to be enrolled on these dates. It is necessary to bring the child's birth certificate and a proof of address, e.g. driving license, electricity bill. Further details will follow regarding registration arrangements for children **returning** to Nursery in August 2013.

Indoor Shoes

In order to ensure the cleanliness of the toys and indoor rugs, it is very important that children have a clean pair of shoes or slippers that they change into when they enter the Nursery. This is to ensure that mud and dirt from outside is not transferred into the play area as much as possible. Thank you very much for your cooperation with this.

Snack

We provide a range of snacks over the week at Nursery. Snack is 30p/£1.50 per day. Please put this is the blue tin that is situated in the cloakroom/welcome area as you enter the Nursery.

Special Books (PLPs)

The children's special books (Personal Learning Portfolios) are situated in the entrance area of the Nursery. Please have a look at these as we are updating them on a regular basis.
