Early Learning and Childcare - Update from Parent Council Meeting I mentioned in the last newsletter about the Council's plans to extend our nursery to ensure *************** delivery of 1140 hours of nursery provision for the Annan Community by the year 2020. Hecklegirth has been chosen for this nursey extension because we are currently under our operating capacity and we have the scope to accommodate the new proposals with out any major building work. This means an extension to our existing school nursery and a move to have all of the mainstream classes P1-7 accommodated in the tower block. The plan is to have all classes ready in the tower block for the start of the new school session on the 21st August. This work will be carried out during the summer holidays. Work will need done in three classrooms. There are no plans available currently but I will let you know more about the changes when I can. Please be assured that the Council are determined to work with the school to ensure safety and ensure that the children's learning will not be compromised in any way. The Council Representatives who attended the Parent Council Meeting on the 24th April are willing to attend another Parent Council Meeting in the future if necessary. Next Steps Meeting to be arranged with Council Representatives and Architects Department to draw up plans for alterations to tower block and plans for the nursery extension The Council will begin consultation with families in Annan to find out what they require in terms of early learning provision to ensure a quality service for the children . The new provision will also incorporate existing child care providers in Annan School to keep you up to date with new information when available .
