Your child's interim report card is being completed by the teacher and will be issued on 21st November. This report will form the basis of discussions at our Family Conversation event. Please look for the report (which will be accompanied by an appointment slip) in your child's bag that day. Duplicate reports are available on request - please call to arrange with the office.

Family Conversations, 29th November, from 3.15pm

Following the report, we invite you to a meeting with your child and the class teacher to discuss current progress. Together you will agree a learning target to help your child achieve their learning potential and this will be recorded during the meeting. An appointment request sheet will be enclosed with your child's report. Parents with a child who attends termly Child Plan Meetings need not attend this event to avoid duplication of information.

Appointments will be issued on a first come, first served basis and will last no more than ten minutes. We appreciate that some families do not all live together however, but due to time restrictions we cannot offer more than one appointment per child so we ask that families work together to come to the appointment together or agree which parent will attend this first meeting. Please remember to return your invitation, even if you do not wish an appointment at this time as we require acknowledgment for our records.
