

## Homework Tasks – second level

**Remember:** Spelling Workout (all lists) and Maths Options (including SumDog) are great ways to improve your skills.

### Spanish Artists

Research the lives and works of Dali and Picasso – create a fact file on each.

Decide which artists work you like best.

Try to create one or two pieces of art in their style.

### Spanish

We are going to be learning the basic greetings and colours in Spanish – can you find and watch some online clips to help you pick up some basic Spanish words?

### Climate Scenarios

Choose one of the headline scenarios below. Think about the impact the natural disaster will have on the people and the landscape. Imagine you are a news reporter. **Write the frontpage story** about the disaster – your information should be accurate from our Weather and Natural disasters project. Include interviews (quote using speech marks!) with victims and experts.



Now turn the frontpage news story into a script for the evening television news. You should think about how you would film it. Who will be in the studio? How will you interview victims and experts?

### **Create and aerobic exercise routine**

It is essential to build some movement into your isolation time (depending on how well you are feeling!)

Pick out some of your favourite music – it helps to have a regular and upbeat tempo.

Draw up a set of exercises which fit with your music choice. Try it out on family members.

You could create a different routine for each day?! Be sure to exercise different parts of the body.

### **Kitchen Science**

Find out which of the solids (food stuffs only!) dissolve in water. Time in cold and hot water; stirring and not stirring.

Make sure you consider fair testing (Only one variable – everything else remains constant).

Record your results – draw up instructions for your fair test. Design a method of collecting and recording your results.

Remove the iron from your breakfast cereal (if you have cereal fortified with iron – Special K, Bran Flakes etc). Put cereal in a sandwich bag; crush into a powder; run a strong magnet over the bag.

How much iron was in your cereal? Find a way to record.

**READ** – a book that has been gathering dust on the shelf or a classic that Mum and Dad hold dear.

### **Digital narratives:**

Watch these non-scripted animations. Write the narrative (the story) be sure to include all the feelings and emotions. Read your story as you play the animation to make sure you haven't missed anything.
