A little everyday!

Count how many...

Lay out buttons, counters or small objects
between 10 and 20, between 20 and 30

Ask your child to count them (be sure they
point and count each object once).

Ask your child to write down the number.

Ask your child to write out all the numbers they
can...up to 20, up to 30 and beyond.

Talk about numbers they have reversed and correct.

Talk about number they have missed and add in.

Now play:

Point and Say - you point to a number, your child tells
you what it is.

Missing Number - child looks away you cover 2
numbers. They turn back and tell you the missing
numbers.

Time:

Just a minute!

You need a timer.

How many jumps can you do in 1
minute?

How many times can you write your
name in 1 minute?

Start counting - which number are you
on after 1 minute?

How many cups can you fill with water
in 1 minute?

Find out 5 other things you can do in
just 1 minute!

Maths for P1 pupils

Adding Cards:

You need a pack of playing cards

Remove jacks, queens, kings and jokers.

Turn over 2 cards.

Add them together.

Write down your questions and answers.

$$6 + 5 = 11$$

$$10 + 3 = 13$$

USE your Big Number Cards...

Make a set of big numbers (a job for your child)
one number on each piece of A4 paper. 10-
20...and beyond

Spread the number pages randomly around the
living room or garden.

Jump on the Number: Ask your child to jump
on the number...11...16 etc.

Big Number Line: put the big numbers in order
on the floor or on the washing line with pegs.
