

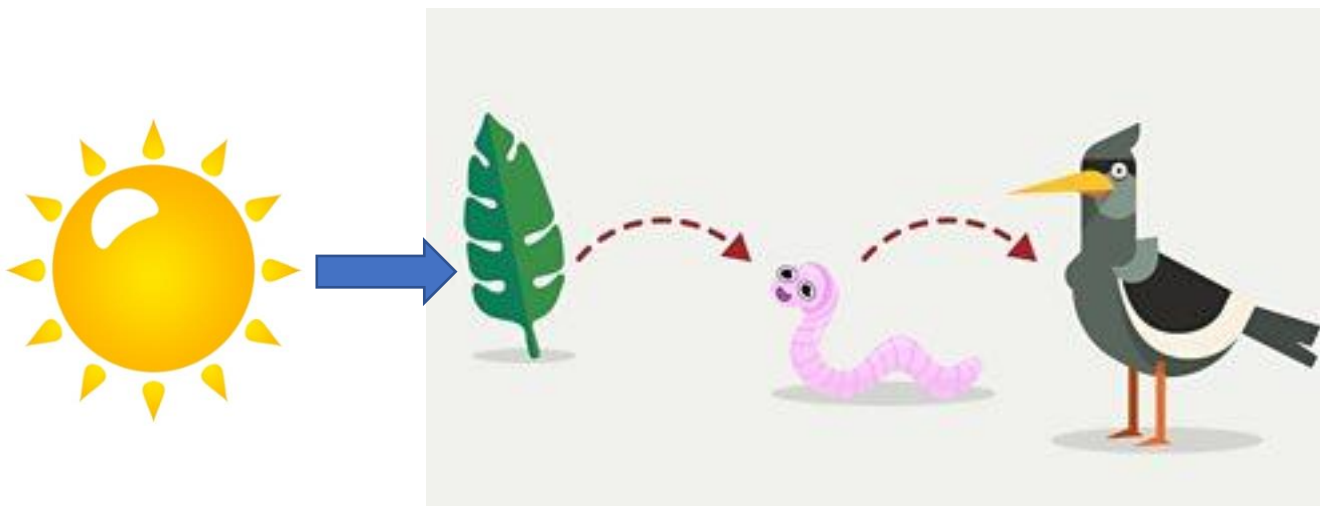
Food Chains

I can show my understanding of how plants and animals depend on each other for food.

- Draw lines to match the words below to the correct descriptions.

The Sun	A consumer in the food chain that eats animals who eat plants
Food Chain	The process plants use to make food
Producer	A series of organisms that rely on each other for food
Consumer	Provides energy for the producer
Photosynthesis	The first consumer in the food chain (eats plants)
Organism	Use energy from the sun to produce their own food
Primary Consumer	Cannot produce their own food, they get their energy from eating other organisms
Secondary Consumer	An individual living thing (animals/plants)

- Have a family discussion- do you already know about some food chains? Carry out some research!
- Below is a picture of a food chain. This picture shows the sun providing a leaf with energy, the leaf is eaten by a worm, then the worm is eaten by a bird. Can you name the producer, primary consumer and secondary consumer in the picture?



- Now it's your turn...try drawing some food chains that you researched. The arrow in the picture means 'is eaten by', it is really important to use the arrows when drawing food chains. If you use the arrows it is clear to see who the producer is, who the primary consumer is and who the secondary consumer is!
- Could you now make a diorama/model/stop motion animation about a food chain?
