

P1 Literacy Activities

Week beginning 27.4.2020

Phonics

I've posted activities and a sheet to help work on the "ar" sound this week.

Practise all the previous sounds we have done too—5/10 minutes a day, reading and writing words.

Read Aloud

Choose a book from the home learning pack, or find a book your child can read fairly independently from home/EPIC.

Find a new place around the house/garden to read your book each day.

Jumbled sentences

Choose 3-5 sentences from a book your child can read independently.

Write each sentence on a strip of paper, but "jumbled-up"

E.g. instead of

The boy went to the park. write
boy to park. the went The

Get your child to cut out the words and unjumble the sentence so it makes sense. It helps work on their understanding. They could then draw a picture to go with their sentences.

Wanted Poster

Get your child to create a Wanted poster for a "baddie" in their book. Think about a character description, what they did, and a reward. See my Big Bag Wolf example below.

Common Words

Keep practising your child's sight words with them. If they can read words confidently without prompting, move on to the next words on the list—I included it in the home learning packs.

Writing

Wee Book—Dear Diary

Write a wee book about what you have been doing this week.

Use words like **On/went/did/I** (write them on paper for your child to help them).

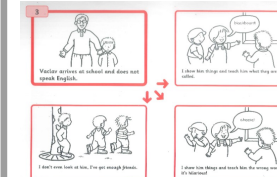
Challenge—can you write an extra sentence telling us more information? Use **It was...**

Remember to remind your child that we are looking for **Capital letters, finger spaces, full stops**. Get them to check.

(My example is on page 3).
