

### Time:

### Make your own clock :

I used old notebook covers (recycling!!)

Make sure you have a long minute hand and a short hour hand.

I used a bowl to draw around for the clock face.

I used a pencil to hold my hands on my face.

### Practise drawing clock faces on your white board:

It is important to make sure the numbers are in the correct place on the clock face.

Now parents set the clock and child reads it : 6 o'clock 3 o'clock 12 o'clock

Now parents tell and pupils set the clock: 7 o'clock 1 o'clock etc.

Now try **half past**, **quarter to** and **quarter past**.

### Choose a different target task each day this week:

- Put all the numbers on order. Start with the smallest.
- Rewrite each row putting the numbers in order from the smallest (then from the largest to smallest)
- Add 10 to each number.
- Double each number. (Remember if you know double 2, you know double 20 and double 200 - look for a pattern)
- Write down all the odd numbers (Can't share equally between 2 people—chunk in 10s)
- Write down all the even numbers ( Can share equally between 2 people—chunk in 10s)
- What number must be added to each number to make 100? (200 sits out!)
- Add one to each number.
- Take one away from each number.
- Take 10 away from each number (zero sits out!)
