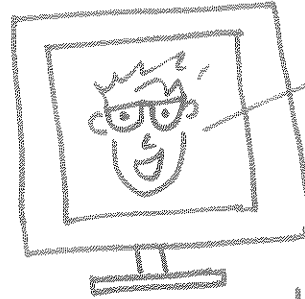
How did we get on last year?

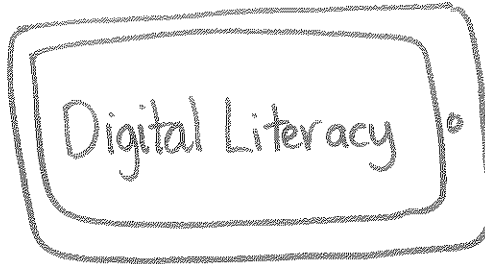
Staff went online to Oz and undertook the first 5 sessions of Balanced Writer.

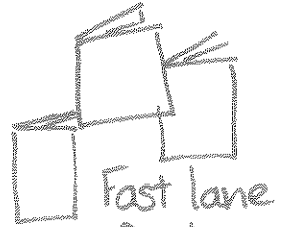
