Congratulations to the pupils who earned speaking parts they are now learning their lines.

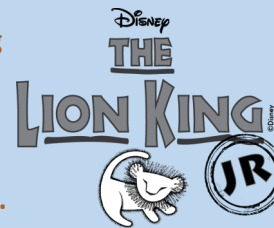
Pupils in school are starting to learn the songs.

We're only one week away from rehearsal week.....

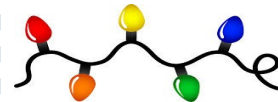
So it is time to get your tickets booked.
