

NURSERY ENROLMENT

If your child's date of birth falls on or between 1st March 2009 and 28th February 2011 you should be deciding upon nursery provision. Pre pre school:-

- Born between 1st March and 19th August 2010 (starting 19th Aug 2013)
- Born between 20th and 31st August 2010 (starting on the day of or after the child's 3rd birthday)
- Born between 1st September and 31st December 2010 (starting January 2014)
- Born between 1st January and 28th February 2011 (starting April 2014)

Pre school:-

 Born between 1st March 2009 and February 2010 (starting August 2013)

Nursery enrolment will take place on the <u>27th and 28th February</u> between 9.00 and 3.00 pm. Please ensure that you bring your child's birth certificate, proof of address and contact telephone numbers for enrolment.

<u>Primary Seven Archaeological Dig</u> Report by P7 Pupils

On Wed 21st November pupils participated in the Castleholm Dig. We were greeted by an archaeologist who introduced us to a machine that we had to jab into the ground. This collected electric currents which could help us measure where the original castle had been built. Twelve pupils had to hold on to a wire that was connected to the machine while two others moved it and poked it into the ground. We had to cover 12 metres of landscape and guess and measure where we thought the corners of the building might be. We all loved taking part in this event and would like the opportunity to do it again.
