There is no 'wrong' way to use the sacks however some will contain suggested activities. Please use them to encourage your child to be imaginative, have fun and hopefully develop a love of books! These are red sacks and will be located in the Nursery Foyer, please ensure you sign them in and out to allow us to account for all sacks.

Following on from our survey on learning conversation evenings around providing you with ideas to support numeracy at home we have now added numeracy bags to the collection. These are located just round the corner from the story bags and are full of simple games/activities you can play at home to promote the development of numeracy with your child.
