SUMMER HOLIDAY FOOD PAYMENT

Younger children in an Early Learning and Childcare settings, Primary and Secondary Pupils who meet eligibility criteria for Free School Meals (low income/qualifying benefits) will receive the Holiday Food Payment of £17.50 per week. This will be paid fortnightly throughout the Summer Holidays. Payment will be made automatically for all eligible children registered to receive Free School Meals - no need to reapply. Families that did not receive the Spring Payment and feel they are eligible will need to apply.
