Edina Trust Grant

Well done to Ms McCall, who successfully applied for £350 grant funding for Science

We have purchased several Science items to support both classroom and outdoor learning;

- A Nature Observation Station with binoculars (installed in the outside classroom)
- Large sheet magnifier frames
- Pooter bug collectors, insect viewer pots and small pond nets
- A 'Pumping Heart' model and stethoscope for learning about how the heart works.
- A 'friction ramp' for testing surfaces
- Metal testing strips (magnetism)
- Technology Pack (wooden dowels/wheels) to make vehicles.
- Moving Toys Design and Technology Class Kit
- Magnetic Polydron
- The Recycling Board Game

I am sure everyone will enjoy the new resources!
