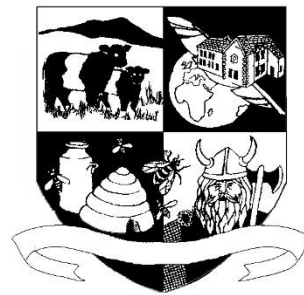

School Self-Evaluation

During the last few months we have been seeking the views of parents, pupils and staff and taking a closer look at our work in school, to inform our priorities for improvement next session.

The following key themes have emerged:

- re-build links with the community and parents
- continue and extend opportunities for outdoor learning
- extend and review the range of methodologies we use to engage our pupils in the learning process
- improve our attainment in literacy, particularly at P1 and P2

These themes will form the basis of our Partnership Improvement Plan for next session.

What we plan to do:

Community Links and Outdoor Learning

- Work in partnership with Active Schools to involve children in sporting opportunities
- Work in partnership with Kirkcudbright Rotary to participate in community events
- Make links with local chaplains to support the RME curriculum
- Seek partnerships with parents and community groups to support the delivery of outdoor learning
- Seek opportunities to extend learning in music
- Run family learning/parent workshops in literacy
- Re-establish volunteers in school

Learning and Teaching Methodologies

- Staff to undertake professional reading
- Staff to share effective strategies with each other
- Staff to try new approaches across curriculum areas

Literacy

- Fully implement the new approach to writing developed in session 2021 - 2022
- Staff will share approaches and discuss methodologies in writing with cluster school colleagues
- Review our approaches and programme for early literacy development (P1-3)
- Develop a school programme for early literacy
- Review our approaches to teaching reading across the school and maximise the potential of Accelerated Reading.
- Run workshops for parents in early literacy development

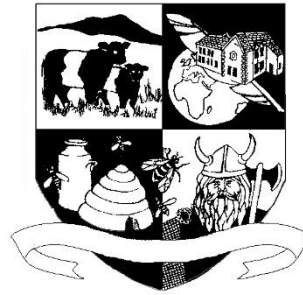
