Maths/Numeracy

The focus this term is on:

Number:

Whole numbers to 10, 100, 1000.

Addition/subtraction.

Practical Maths ~ Data Handling

P1 ~ Sorting, Pictographs and Carol Diagrams.

P2 ~ Bar Graphs, Tally Marks and Sorting Data.

P3/4 ~ Frequency Tables, creating and interpreting Bar Charts.

Mental Maths

The children work on mental maths tasks 3 times per week.

Health & Wellbeing

Our Health/wellbeing theme this term is Road Safety.

We will continue to participate in the Daily Mile ~ walking/jogging/running within the school grounds each day, weather permitting.

PE ~ Ball Skills then Scottish Dancing, will take place on Monday & Wednesday/Thursday afternoons.

Please bring a water bottle daily and a PE KIT for the whole week, bring it on a Monday and take home on Friday.

Religious and Moral Education

We will be learning about Hallowe'en, Guy Fawkes, Remembrance and the Christmas Story.

We will also take part in our Christmas show during the last week of term.

English/Literacy

Talking and Listening

Circle time/show and tell is on Wednesday and Thursday mornings, the children talk about experiences, learn to wait for their turn, listen to others & ask/answer questions. The children are involved with topic planning, discussing what they want to learn. We have weekly Listening Skills tasks. Children also meet with other pupils in their house teams to self and peer assess examples of their work.

Reading

~ PM Nelson/Oxford Reading Tree schemes and comprehension tasks. Children will participate in the Reading for Life challenge to encourage independent reading.

Writing

Personal writing weekly, spelling/phonics, grammar and dictionary skills are ongoing.

We will be looking at how to write effective Recounts this term.

Expressive Arts

Art: Christmas themed arts and crafts.

Music: We will be learning Christmas songs for the show and playing some percussion instruments with Mrs Picken on Monday afternoons.



Modern Languages

We are learning vocabulary for months of the year, birthdays and Christmas in France.

Interdisciplinary Learning Topic (IDL)

Alongside our Christmas activities, the topic this term is Electricity. We will look at how/where and why we use electricity and keeping safe around electrical items. We also hope to investigate circuits, looking at some symbols that represent the components and together, draw and build a simple circuit.

Home Learning

Literacy and/or numeracy based (and sometimes topic related) homework for each class will be given on Tuesdays/Wednesdays to be returned on or before the Tuesday of the following week, thank you.
