## Maths/Numeracy

We are focusing on:-

- Learning and consolidating times tables
- Division
- Fractions
- Decimals
- Time

**HWB** lessons are looking at substance misuse and assessing and managing risk in order to keep SAFE in line with the SHANARRI indicators.

**Art** lessons will explore transfer print (using chalk/wax), block printing, string block printing, stencil print, mono print, distorted print, printing with found objects, as well as clay modelling.
