- Create a haven for birds in the school garden.
- Make bird feeders.

We are also seeking to gain our Eco flag and will be focusing on this on Mondays and Tuesdays as a whole school. Recycling, reducing waste: water, electricity, paper and food. Pollination and planning to encourage more insects into the garden; flowers, bug/bird houses.
