We are learning about foods, expressing our likes and dislikes and personal information.

Expressive Arts

Art and Design – Using different media to create pictures and models linked to IDL.

Music – Listening to Spanish music and exploring musical sounds from around the world.

Interdisciplinary Learning Topic (IDL)

Local Nature

This term we will be learning about our local nature, learning about different habitats, animals that live there and issues that arise in the community. The children will be researching using different resources looking at different habitats and creating a storyline.

Oceans

We are investigating the impact that oceans have on our world, exploring life under the ocean waves and the threats to this habitat. This will link with our class novel Kensuke's Kingdom, examining life in different countries and comparing biomes across the world.
