All children have the right to be protected from harm, abuse and neglect.

Every adult in Scotland has a role in ensuring all our children live safely and have the opportunity to reach their full potential. The vision for all children in Dumfries and Galloway is that they should be: Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Respected, Responsible and Included.

These are also known as 'Wellbeing Indicators'.

The Headteacher (Mr. Stuart Hunter) is the School's Child Protection Coordinator.

In the event of the Headteacher's absence from school, the Depute Headteachers (Mrs. Siân Walker and Mrs. Rachael McGhie) will assume the role of Child Protection Coordinators.

The Nursery Manager (Mrs. Karen Newell) will assume this role within the Nursery.
