

Refresh of the Digital Literacy strategy after D&G Windows 10 rollout

Progress

- Windows 10 has not yet been rolled out across Primary schools in D&G
- All teachers have completed an individual skills audit for every pupil – this has highlighted strengths along with next steps for improvement.
- Good progress made on Digital Awards Self-evaluations

Curriculum Refresh

Refresh of our curriculum following new documentation from D&G and national guidance

Progress

- Teachers met and individually completed and traffic lighted our curriculum against a series of key indicators from HGIOS 2.2 – this was very positive and evidenced the strength of our curriculum (as did Educ Scot visit in June 2019 at Caerlaverock).
- Staff completed an audit looking at every area of the curriculum by linking it to the attributes and capabilities of the Four Capacities – again this highlighted the strength of our curriculum.

Pupil Ownership & Parental Engagement

Continue to develop pupil ownership of their learning and promote parental engagement

Progress

- Due to lockdown, this did not progress as planned – both schools have agreed there is a need to move from our paper *Journals of Excellence* to a digital platform.
- Teaching videos, Team meetings and *D&G Framework for Numeracy* materials supported parents with their understanding of how literacy and numeracy develop, and how they can help at home.
