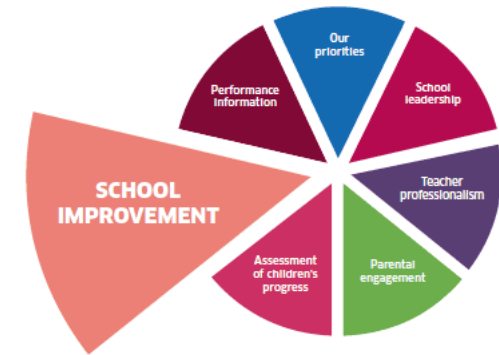

Refresh of the Digital Literacy strategy after D&G Windows 10 rollout

Progress

- Windows 10 now rolled out
- School equipment proved challenging this session – many laptops were away for repair or had to be discarded – have been able to purchase five new laptops
- Almost all teaching staff completed Digital Literacy Learning & Teaching programme with Education Scotland
- All teachers have completed an individual skills audit for every pupil –this has highlighted strengths along with next steps for improvement.
- Good progress made on Digital Awards Self-evaluations
- Digital skills have been added to all our IDL bundles to ensure they are visited on a planned basis
