 - To make progress with 'Learning for Sustainability'.

- After school club is underway, Active Schools will be focusing on football. Three weekly sessions for both the P1-4 and P5-7 class.

- School has received 20 Microbits, which are interactive coding devices (see microbit.org for more information).
