Treasurer	 No changes since our last meeting Agreement will have to be reached as how much the winners will get for the bonus ball as there are fewer people participating in this now PK will put together a leaflet that will be shared with parents
Head Teacher	 Swimming for P4 pupils started today. This will take place on Tues, Wed & Thurs for the next three weeks. As we managed to involve P4 & 5 pupils last year, none of our pupils missed out due to Covid. D&G are paying for the bus this year. DHS is our catchment secondary school. P7 pupils have had a visit from Mr Cubbon, HT and have some dates arranged for activities eg HWB day, Play in a day Learning consultations will take place on the evening of Wed 23rd Nov Both Parent Councils have agreed that we hold a joint disco at Brownhall, with each paying £30 for the DJ. Depending upon numbers, we may have to split P1/2/3/4 (6-7pm) and P5/6/7 (7-8pm). Purple Mash – this is a fantastic resource that the children can use at home and at school. Teachers have been working on online training for this. Can be used for coding, numeracy, literacy Panto – in the past we have used Shooglie Road productions, but we have heard nothing from them, although AC has sent an email. Going to a live performance in either Dumfries or Carlisle is very expensive. It was agreed that both parent Councils will pay for the cost of an online production – the code can be shared with parents who could access it at home.
