



# Carrutherstown School Uniform

All Dumfries and Galloway schools have a dress code which encourages pupils to dress in a way appropriate to attendance at school. We aim for our children to look smart, yet be comfortable and have a uniform that enables them to take part in active learning experiences.

We ask that all children adhere to our dress code, which is:

- Blue school sweatshirt / sweatcardi (Plain blue jumpers or cardigans are also acceptable)
- Blue/ white checked dress
- White polo shirt (available with school badge but plain white is acceptable)
- Grey / black trousers / skirts
- Outdoor and indoor shoes/trainers (a pair of separate indoor shoes / plimsolls to wear in school and suitable outdoor shoes and coat for break time / outdoor learning—wellies may be appropriate through the winter months)



## P.E. Kit

It is essential that children have a P.E. kit that is **kept in school** to enable them to participate comfortably and safely in physical activity and sport. We ask that the children keep a P.E. kit in school so that it is ready for use as and when P.E. sessions may take place. This can be returned at holiday periods to wash. **We are asking for a white T-shirt and black shorts to be provided and kept in school and also an appropriate pair or trainers/plimsolls (these could be the same as indoor shoes).**
