Learning Intention: *To research information about a local soldier from World War One.*

Success Criteria:

- *To use a website to search for information about a chosen soldier.*
- *To select information that is relevant to that soldier.*
- *To put information onto a suitable format (PowerPoint, poster etc)*
- *To share information with others.*

Task:

Your child has chosen a name from the war memorial in town. Please assist your child to use the website to find information e.g. Regiment, date killed and where.

The amount of information available for each soldier may vary depending on their service records.

Once you have carried out the research the information can be displayed in a format of your choice. (Written report, Poster, Collection of photographs, Powerpoint)

Children will then share the information with the class and we will create a database of those local soldiers who lost their lives in WW1.
