

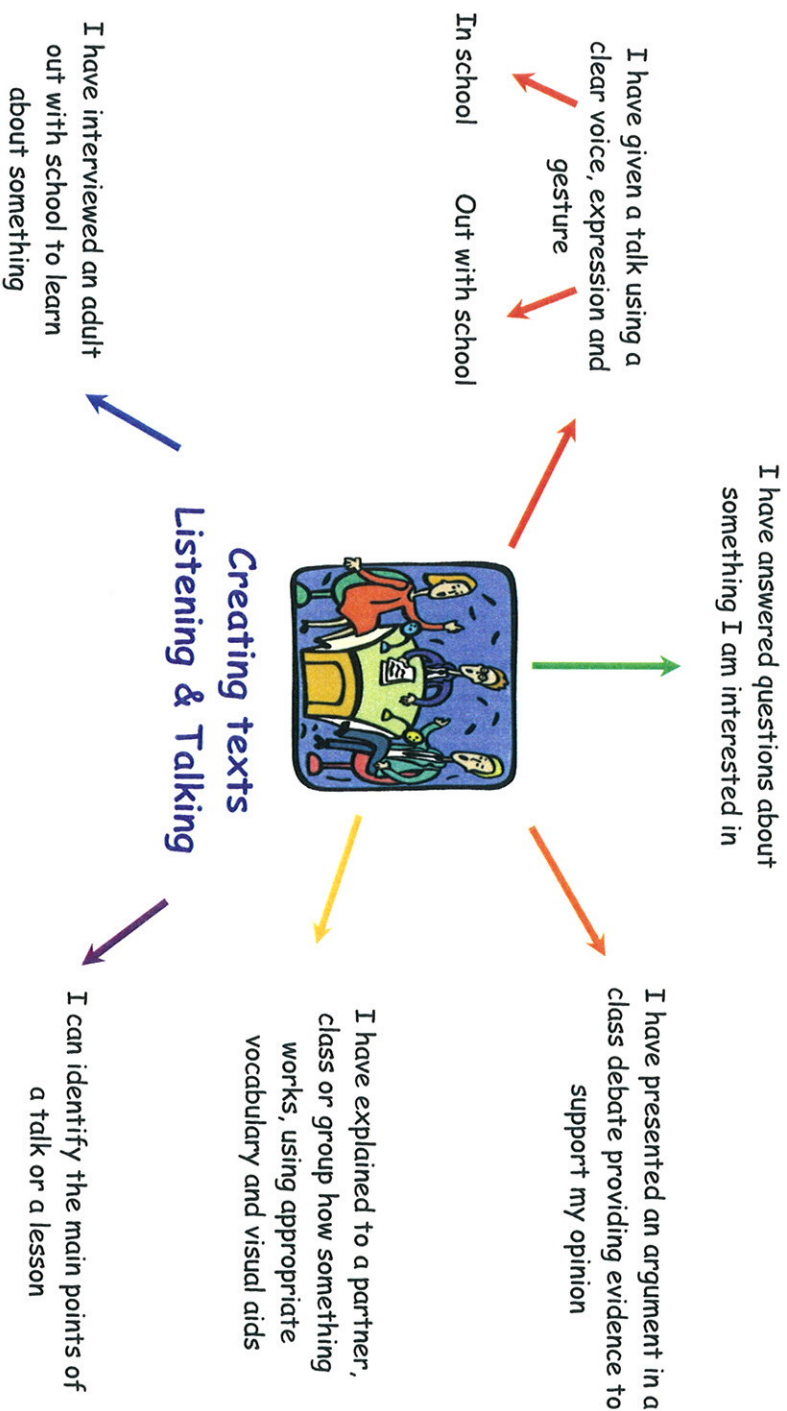


When listening and talking with others, for different purposes, I can:

- * clarify points by asking questions or by asking others to say more.

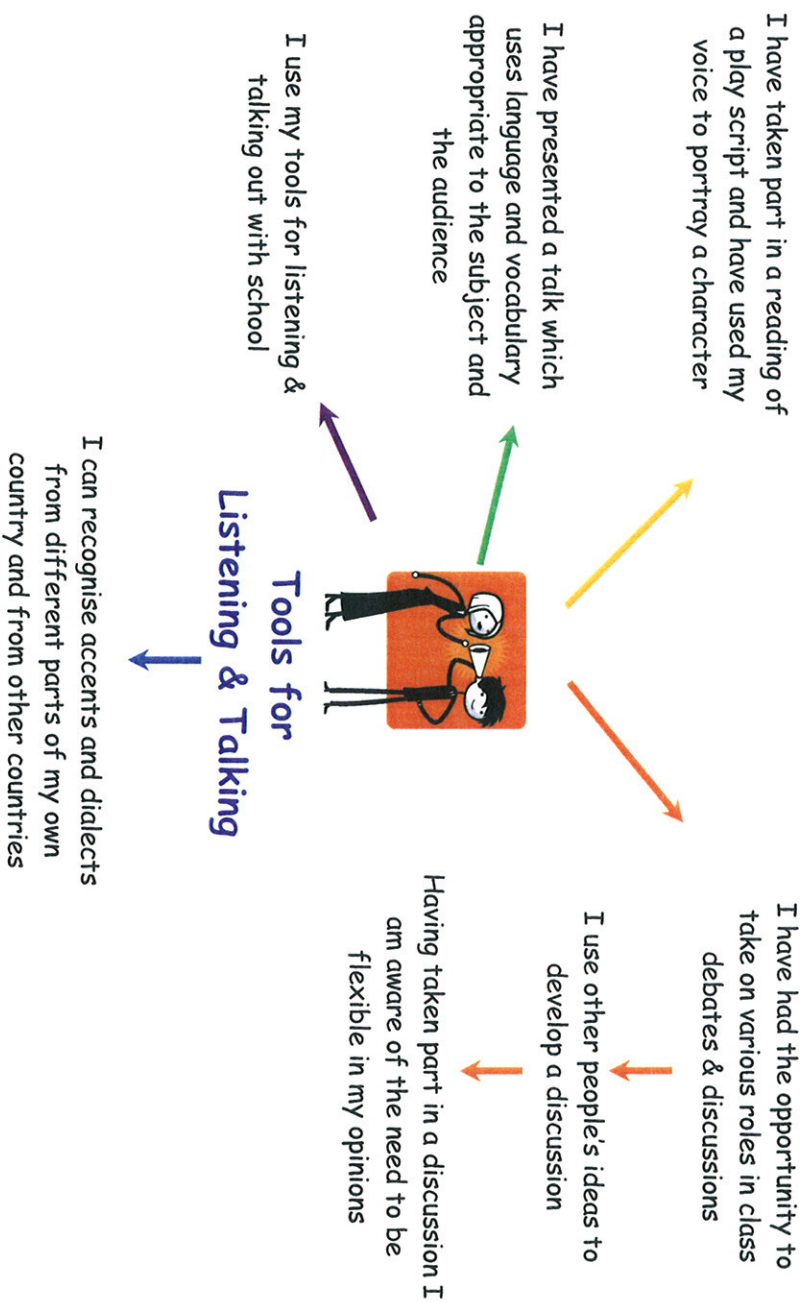

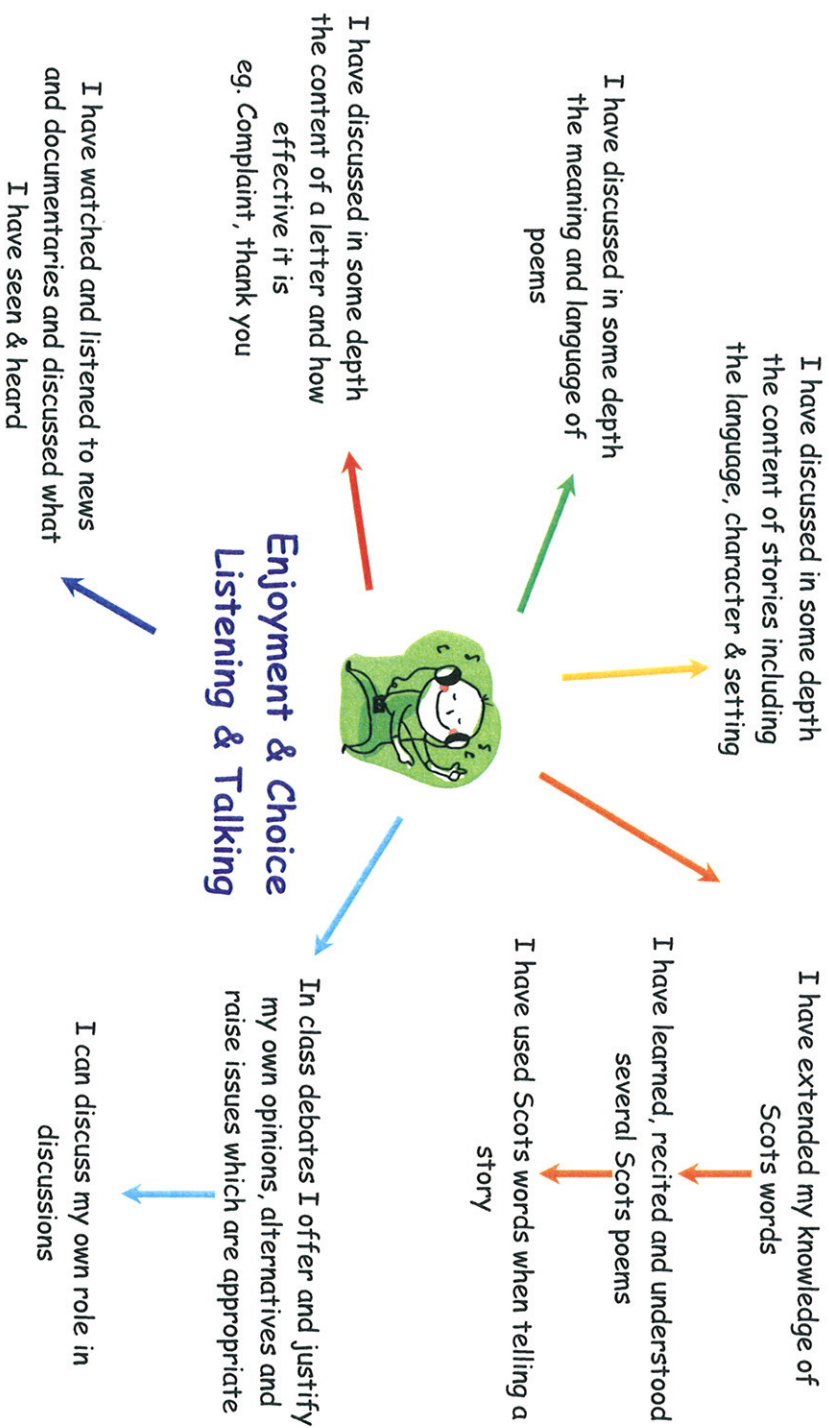
